

NYC School Survey:

Every year, all parents, teachers, students in grades 6-12 and select school support staff take the NYC School Survey. The survey helps school leaders understand what key members of their school community think about the learning environment at their school.

Families should enter "f" followed by their child's ninedigit Student Identification (OSIS) Number to access the survey. Note that "f" must be lowercase. Families can find their child's Student Identification Number on their report card, student ID card, or New York City Schools Account (NYCSA).
